A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CITY OFFICIALS TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE LAKE SAINT LOUIS BOULEVARD SOUTH PHASE 1 IMPROVEMENT PROJECT REQUESTING FUNDS FROM ST. CHARLES COUNTY ROAD BOARD ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF LAKE SAINT LOUIS, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, St. Charles County Road Board provides funding for road improvement projects in St. Charles County; and

WHEREAS, City staff has requested authorization to submit a grant application to improve Lake Saint Louis Boulevard south of I-64; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen have determined that it is necessary, desirable and in the best interest of the City to make application for the aforementioned program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN for the City of Lake Saint Louis, Missouri as follows:

**SECTION 1. Application Form.** The Board of Aldermen authorizes staff to submit a grant application to the St. Charles County Road Board on behalf of the City of Lake Saint Louis.

**SECTION 2. Further Action.** The Mayor, City Administrator and other appropriate City officials are hereby authorized to take any and all actions as may be deemed necessary or convenient to carry out and comply with the intent of this resolution, and to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, all documents as may be necessary, desirable, convenient or proper to perform all matters herein authorized.

**SECTION 3. Effectiveness.** This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage by the Board of Alderman and approval by the Mayor.

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF PROPOSITION R, PROPOSING THE RE-AUTHORIZATION OF THE ST. CHARLES COUNTY TRANSPORTATION SALES TAX FOR THE APRIL 5, 2022 GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT

**WHEREAS**, the St. Charles County one-half cent transportation sales tax was first approved by the voters in 1985; and

**WHEREAS**, the one-half cent transportation sales tax has been re-authorized three times in 1994, 2004, 2012, and now needs a majority vote to re-authorize its collection for another 10 years; and

**WHEREAS**, funds from this tax are used for construction, reconstruction and repair of roads and bridges throughout St. Charles County, including for road and bridge projects proposed by the municipalities; and

**WHEREAS**, the sales tax generates approximately \$30 million a year for road and bridge improvement projects that enhance the mobility and safety of our local roads; and

**WHEREAS**, Proposition R would extend the date of the one-half cent tax to 2036; and

**WHEREAS**, the St. Charles County Road Board solicits applications for road improvements from the County Highway Department and municipalities in the county; and

**WHEREAS**, the board evaluates these applications to formulate recommendations to the County Executive for road improvements to be funded; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Executive, in consideration of these recommendations, prepares a three year Transportation Improvement Plan, which is submitted to the County Council for approval; and

**WHEREAS**, the revenues which result from the county's ½ cent Transportation Sales Tax have been used to construct major projects like the Page Avenue Extension (MO Route 364), to improve local arterials such as Lake St. Louis Boulevard and Hawk Ridge Trail, and to provide traffic flow and safety upgrades on collector roads such as Civic Center Drive, Freymuth Road, and Old Highway N in the City of Lake St. Louis; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Lake St. Louis recognizes that transportation improvements are crucial to the continued development and growth of St. Charles County.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF LAKE ST. LOUIS  
MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. The City of Lake St. Louis hereby supports the St. Charles County Council for the re-authorization of the one-half cent Transportation Sales Tax and placement on the April 5, 2022 General Election Ballot for a vote of the people.

SECTION 2. That the citizens of the City of Lake St. Louis are hereby urged to exercise their privilege to vote by going to the polls on April 5, 2022 and are further urged to consider supporting Proposition R based upon its merits.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk is hereby directed to send a copy of this Resolution to the St. Charles County Council.
