S. Henke Transformer Location

George Ertle, City Administrator, presented information about relocating the transformer located on the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints' property at the intersection of Ridgepointe Place Circle and S. Henke. The updated estimate for the cost of the relocation is \$14,000.

The Board held a general discussion about the transformer. The Board directed staff to proceed with the transformer relocation project.
