1. Director's Report: Department Updates

Maintenance/Projects

- Playground flooring installed at Founder's Park.
- DRB approved restroom plans at the Nature Park off Duello Rd.
- Tree Board to review 4 educational pieces to be placed at the nature park.

Programming and Special Events

- Review of Covid-19 precautions: Parks are open but playgrounds, splash pad, restrooms and drinking fountains closed.
- April-May facility rentals canceled.
- Programming and Events canceled through May.
- Triathlon and Day Camp canceled for 2020.
- Youth Baseball league anticipated to begin June 1.

2. Budget FY20/21-General Overview and Capital Projects

- Parks Director led a budget presentation
- 20/21 budget reduced.
- Capital Projects approved:
 - i. Playground at Boulevard Park
 - ii. Funds for "No Name Park"-Nature Park off Duello Rd.
 - iii. Trail repairs at Boulevard Park

3. No Name Park

- Director presented naming results for the "No Name Park" from online survey:
 - i. 100 votes tallied
 - ii. 47 percent of votes in favor of Deer Ridge Park.

- All board members in favor of naming the new park development recommended by survey results.
- Board approves the name: Deer Ridge Park
- Park Director led presentation of a virtual photo walkthrough of Deer Ridge Park including maps and photos of park development.
- Park Board discussed pavilion location and sizes and restroom design.
- Park Board to discuss signage, rules, trail names and trail head ideas at the next meeting.

Board Discussion: Board asked for clarification on the start of the youth baseball league. Discussion of loss of registrations compared to 2019 spring baseball league and loss of concessions.

Adjournment: There being no further business to come before the board, Shane Hegarty made a motion to adjourn, second was provided by Dr. Alicia Long, and with a vote of All Ayes, the meeting was adjourned at 7:57 PM.
