CANDIDATE FILING INFORMATION
DECLARATION OF CANDIDACY
FOR OFFICE

The City of Lake Saint Louis, Missouri will hold a Municipal Election, Tuesday, April 4, 2017 for the purpose of electing a Mayor to serve a four-year term and one (1) Alderman to serve a two-year term from each of the City's three (3) Wards.

Candidate filing for the April 4, 2017 election opens at 8:00 a.m. Tuesday, December 13, 2016 and closes at 5:00 p.m. Tuesday, January 17, 2017. City Hall office hours are Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Chapter 110, Article II, Section 110.080 of the Municipal Code of the City of Lake Saint Louis provides that no person shall be Mayor unless he/she be at least twenty-five (25) years of age, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of the City at the time of and for at least one (1) year next preceding his/her election.

Chapter 110, Article I, Section 110.010 of the Municipal Code of the City of Lake Saint Louis, and Chapter 79.070 RSMo, provide that no person shall be an Alderman unless he or she be at least eighteen (18) years of age, a citizen of the United States, and an inhabitant and resident of the City for one (1) year next preceding his or her election, and a resident, at the time he or she files and during the time he or she serves, of the ward from which he or she is elected.

FORMS FOR NOTICE OF INTENTION TO RUN FOR ELECTIVE OFFICE IN THE CITY OF LAKE SAINT LOUIS, MISSOURI ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY APRIL 4, 2017 WILL BE MADE AVAILABLE IN THE CITY CLERK'S OFFICE, ACCORDING TO STATE STATUES, AS FOLLOWS:

All persons desiring names to be placed on the ballot as candidates for office shall file a Notice of Intention to Run with the City Clerk at City Hall, 200 Civic Center Drive, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except that the first day for said filing shall begin at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, December 13, 2016. Such notice shall set forth the name of the candidate, address, age, length of residence and the office for which he/she is running.

It is hereby ordered and directed that the last day for filing for office in the City of Lake Saint Louis for the election that shall be held in the City on the first Tuesday of April, after the first Monday, being April 4, 2017, shall be January 17, 2017. Only those names of candidates received by 5:00 p.m. on January 17, 2017 shall be placed on the ballot.

For candidates filing on the first day (December 13, 2016) and the last day (January 17, 2017), the order of filing will be determined by random drawing. From December 14, 2016 through January 16, 2017 candidates for each office will appear on the ballot in the order in which his/her written declaration of candidacy is filed with the City Clerk's office.
