1. ***DISCUSSION MAY MEETING***

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Chairman Young said he sent a thank you to Andrea Hughes but informed her that the Committee will not do fundraiser events but looks forward to working with her in the future on recycling events. He noted that he received an "out of the office" reply to his email.

**2. DISCUSSION OF CA MEETING**

Committeeman Ellis said Ryan Largura, Environmental Specialist with the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, came and spoke at a June 19<sup>th</sup> meeting at the CA clubhouse. Committeeman Ellis stated it was not well attended. A PowerPoint presentation was shown regarding water quality in general and the lakes and Peroque Creek watershed noting that he has a copy of the PowerPoint presentation. Committeeman Ellis said he received a watershed plan from 2003 or 2004. He also received copies of biological and physical assessments for Lake Saint Louis noting these were all focused on his goal regarding water quality measurement data.

The Committee had a discussion regarding obtaining water quality data.

**3. COMMUNICATION UPDATE**

Chairman Young stated the rain barrel ordinance passed. He noted that an article should be placed in Newstime regarding the ordinance and where to purchase them.

The Committee had a discussion regarding where rain barrels can be purchased.

Vice Chairman Kallunki-Baniak stated she needs to get an article in Newstime regarding the electronic recycling event.

**4. ELECTRONICS RECYCLING**

The Committee discussed the status of the Electronics Recycling Event at The Meadows. It was noted that there is some finalization regarding the application and WITS proof of liability insurance. The forklift and driver are in place and there is still need for volunteers. The event is Saturday, September 27<sup>th</sup>.

**5. OLD BUSINESS**

Chairman Young stated that Alderman Pellerito was going to talk about his work on doing mitigation of flooding upper part of Peroque Creek.

The Committee discussed Peroque Creek.

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**6. NEW BUSINESS**

Committeeman Ellis said he went to the Lakes and Parks Committee meeting and was struck by some of the concerns the members had of items being done in the City. Committeeman Ellis said one of the concerns dealt with the Huck's Gas Station and Convenience Store not flowing into the lake.

Steve Schertel, Director of Community Development, stated the construction plans have been approved and how run off would be handled.

Committeeman Ellis questioned the Shell Gas Station/Convenience Store's and Phillips 66 Gas Station/Convenience Store's run off located near Interstate 70.

Mr. Schertel discussed how the discharge is handled at those locations.

Committeeman Ellis mentioned the water sewer replacement project.

The Committee had a discussion regarding the water sewer replacement project.

Committeeman Ellis stated the Ambassadors Club is working with other clubs on having a Fall Festival, Saturday, September 13<sup>th</sup> at Windjammer Point. He stated who will be helping with the Festival and the events at the Festival.
