

APPLICATION FOR LIQUOR LICENSE

RENEWAL OF LICENSE _____

_____, the undersigned, hereby makes application to the Board of Aldermen of the City of Lake Saint Louis, Missouri, for a liquor license to be issued to _____, under the provisions of Chapter 600, of the Lake Saint Louis Municipal Code, and amendments thereto, and more particularly under the provisions of Section 600.070 License fees, below indicated:

1. For the sale of all kinds of intoxicating liquor at retail by the drink for consumption on the premises of the licensee, which shall include the sale of intoxicating liquor in the original package, shall be the sum of:

\$450.00 PER YEAR

2. For the sale at retail by the drink for consumption on the premises where sold of malt liquor containing alcohol in excess of three and two-tenths percent (3.2%) by weight and not in excess of five percent (5%) by weight and for the similar sale of non-intoxicating beer, shall be the sum of:

\$52.50 PER YEAR

3. For the sale in the original package not for consumption on the premises nor for resale of non-intoxicating beer and of malt liquor having an alcohol content of not less than one-half of one percent (.5%) by volume nor exceeding three and two-tenths percent (3.2%) by weight by grocers and other merchants who are permitted to make such sales under the provisions of this Chapter, shall be the sum of:

\$22.50 PER YEAR

4. For the sale in the original package, not for consumption on the premises nor for resale of intoxicating liquors, alcohol for beverage purposes, spirituous, vinous, fermented, malt or liquors or any combination of liquors, a part of which is spirituous, vinous or containing an excess of three and two-tenths percent (3.2%) of alcohol fermented or preparations or mixtures for beverage purposes by weight, such license shall be the sum of:

\$125.00 PER YEAR

5. For the sale at retail by the drink for consumption on the premises where sale of non-intoxicating beer containing alcohol in excess of three and two-tenths percent (3.2%) by weight and not in excess of five percent (5%) by weight and/or light wines not in excess of fourteen percent (14%) of alcohol by weight/volume made exclusively from grapes, berries and other fruits and vegetables. Said permit shall be issued only for the day or days named therein and it shall not authorize the sale of aforesaid malt liquor or light wine for more than seven (7) days by any said organization as described above hereby referred to as a "picnic license", shall be the sum of:

\$5.00 PER EVENT

6. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Chapter to the contrary, any person who possesses the qualifications required by this Chapter, and who now or hereafter meets the requirements of and complies with the provisions of this Chapter, may apply to the City Clerk, for and upon approval of the Board of Aldermen, the City Clerk may issue a license to sell intoxicating liquor as defined in this Chapter between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and Midnight on Sunday by the drink at retail for consumption on the premises of any restaurant bar as described in the application.
7. The special license fee for Sunday sales as provided for in Section 600.040(E)(10) shall be the sum of :

\$300.00 PER YEAR

8. Provided however, that no licensee holding a license to sell malt liquor or intoxicating liquor, either for consumption on the premises where sold or in the original package and not for consumption on the premises where sold, containing alcohol in excess of three and two-tenths percent (3.2%) by weight shall sell, give away or otherwise dispose of or suffer the same to be done in, upon or about his/her premises on Sunday, unless licensed to do so as herein above provided, or upon the day of any general, special or primary election or upon any County, township, City, town or municipal election day.
9. For sale at retail of malt liquor (beer) and/or light wines containing not in excess of fourteen percent (14%) of alcohol by weight/volume made exclusively from grapes, berries and other fruits and vegetables by the drink for consumption on the premises where sold may be issued to any church, school, civic, service, fraternal, veteran, political or charitable club or organization for the sale of such malt liquor (beer) containing alcohol in excess of five percent (5%) by weight and/or light wine at a picnic, bazaar, fair or similar gathering, shall be the sum of:

\$25.00 PER EVENT

10. For sale in the original package, not for consumption on the premises nor for resale of malt liquor (beer) and/or light wines containing not in excess of fourteen percent (14%) of alcohol by weight/volume made exclusively from grapes, berries and other fruits and vegetables, shall be the sum of:

\$125.00

11. The original package wine tasting license fee, shall be the sum of:

\$25.00 PER YEAR

12. The license fee for sales of liquor of all kinds by the drink at retail for consumption on the premises of any amusement place, shall be the sum of:

\$300.00

SECTION 600.110: TEMPORARY LOCATION FOR LIQUOR BY THE DRINK, CATERERS -- PERMIT AND FEE REQUIRED -- OTHER LAWS APPLICABLE, EXCEPTION

A. The City may issue a temporary permit to caterers and other persons holding licenses to sell intoxicating liquor by the drink at retail for consumption on the premises pursuant to the provisions of this Chapter who furnish provisions and service for use at a particular function, occasion or event at a particular location other than the licensed premises, but not including a "festival" as defined in Chapter 316, RSMo. The temporary permit shall be effective for a period not to exceed one hundred twenty (120) consecutive hours, and shall authorize the service of alcoholic beverages at such function, occasion or event during the hours at which alcoholic beverages may lawfully be sold or served upon premises licensed to sell alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption. For every permit issued pursuant to the provisions of this Section, the permittee shall pay to the Director of Revenue the sum of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) for each calendar day, or fraction thereof, for which the permit is issued.
