



NOVEMBER 2016 – CONSTRUCTION PROJECT UPDATE

PROJECTS UNDER CONSTRUCTION

1. 16 Harbor View Drive

This project will consist of replacing the existing storm sewer pipe and curb inlets from Harbor View Drive to the lake. The design for this project will be done by City staff. A budget amount of \$80,000 has been set for construction.

Staff has contracted with Cochran Engineering to perform a design survey for the amount of \$1,980. Mick Mehler and Sons, Inc was selected as the lowest and best bid and have been contracted to do the project for \$101,214.50. Construction began July 19th. All stormsewer pipe and stormsewer structures have been installed. The street has been restored, and sod has been installed. This project is complete, with a total project cost of \$105,651.10.

2. Antoinette Terrace Stormsewer Cleaning Project

This project consists of cleaning debris from roughly 415 LF of various size pipe from Dauphine Drive to the lake. A budget of \$75,000.00 has been set for this project. Visu-Sewer was selected as the lowest and best bid, at \$13,650.00. The anticipated start date for this project is November 28, 2016.

3. 24 Picardy Drive Stormwater Improvement Project

This project will consist of reconstructing the existing stormwater facilities from Freymuth Road to Picardy Drive. George Butler Associates was selected to design this project. This project is currently in the contract negotiation phase.

PROJECTS UNDER DESIGN

1. Yard Drive Improvement Project

This project will reconstruct the existing roadway between Charlemagne Drive and S. Charlemagne Drive. Reconstruction will consist of a new pavement section, curb and gutter, and enclosed drainage. Staff is currently in the process of selecting a design consultant for the project.

2. **Lake Saint Louis Blvd – Phase 1 Improvement Project**

The Lake Saint Louis Blvd Phase 1 Improvement Project is a full depth resurfacing project from Chase Court to Pleasant Meadow Drive. Staff is currently in the process of selecting a design consultant for the project.

3. **LSL – VMP- I70 Roundabout Study**

Staff secured a Saint Charles Road Board Grant to prepare a concept study to improve the function of the two closely spaced signals at Veterans Memorial Parkway and the east bound ramps of I-70 on Lake Saint Louis Boulevard.

Oates and Associates was selected as the consultant to analyze the functionality of converting the intersections to a roundabout. The study results will be used to complete future grant applications.

The concept study is scheduled to be completed in 2016.

4. **Ridgeway Avenue - Deloire Drive Resurfacing Project**

This project will resurface Ridgeway Avenue from Hawk Ridge Trail to Oakborough Drive and Deloire Drive from Veterans Memorial Parkway to Savoy Drive. The project cost estimate is \$260,000, of which staff secured a Federal Surface Transportation grant in the amount of \$208,000.

Staff is currently completing the project plans and construction is scheduled for summer of 2017.
