

Drawing Supply List

Art supplies can be found at Michael's Arts and Crafts Store

- 14" x 17" Strathmore drawing tablet
- Drawing pencils 2H, 2B, 6B, 9B
- General's Charcoal 4 pencil set with white pencil
- #2 school pencils
- Kneaded eraser
- Papermate (or similar) white eraser stick (similar eraser sticks can also be found in office supply stores)
- Pencil sharpener with cover (hand-held)
- Tortillon/stumps med. Size
- Canson tracing tablet 9" x 12" (or larger) for designing & layout
- Masking tape
- 2" – 3" paintbrush (hardware store variety)
- Wipes (travel-size packet)
- White mat 8" x 10" – outside dimension (choose standard ready-made inexpensive quality)
- Scissors
- ½ in. – 1 in 3 ring binder for instructor's handouts
