

Water Color Supply List

- 11 x 15 watercolor tablet
 - 140 lb cold-pressed paper
- Watercolor paints
 - Cadmium yellow
 - Cadmium red
 - Alizarin crimson
 - Ultramarine blue
 - Burnt sienna
 - Ivory black

(This is a basic list. As you progress, additional colors may be needed.)

Brushes are extremely important!

Please choose three round brushes to start with, #6, #8, and #10, round watercolor brushes—Choose Golden Talkon watercolor brushes. They are good synthetic brushes that will keep a proper point. (Grumbacher Golden Edge at Michael's)

*1"- 2" flat watercolor brush (do not need immediately)

- Drawing Board (for paper support)
 - Or similar support of Masonite or hard panel 24" x 16" approx.
- Terry towel

Plastic Palette:

Any watercolor palette with large divided trays for mixing—Please avoid the smaller palettes that have tiny divided trays that have tiny divided trays. (Divided plastic plates make great economical palettes.)

- Masking tape & scissors
- Paper towels
- #2 drawing pencils and kneaded eraser
- 2 plastic oversize containers for water & fine spray plastic water bottle (small)
- Terry towel
- Wipes for hand & table clean-up
- Tracing paper tablet 9" x 12" for design & layout
- Saral transfer paper (can be purchased from the instructor)
