NOVEMBER 6, 2023

The Board of Aldermen for the City of Lake Saint Louis, Missouri, met in an Administrative/Finance/Public Works Joint Work Session on Monday, November 6, 2023, at 5:45 p.m.

ROLL CALL:

Mayor Law was present and presided over the meeting. Aldermen present: Justin Hensley, Ward III; Sandy Grassmuck, Ward I; Tom Mispagel, Ward II; and Jacalyn Schauer, Ward I. Alderman Mike Mathison, Ward II, and Alderman Chris Hinkle, Ward III, were absent. Also present: George Ertle, City Administrator; Donna Daniel, City Clerk; Andrew Stanislav, Community Development Director; Chris DiGiuseppi, Police Chief; Terry Rigdon, Public Works Director; Renee Camp, Finance Director; and Sarah Belcher, Assistant City Administrator.

MoDOT ROW Mowing

George Ertle, City Administrator, asked the Board if they want to extend the existing Growing Together agreement for the calendar year 2024.

The Board held a general discussion about the service agreement. There was no opposition to extending the existing agreement.

LAGERS - Emergency Telecommunicators

George Ertle, City Administrator, informed the Board that Governor Parsons signed legislation that allows Missouri LAGERS employers the option to classify emergency telecommunicators (dispatchers) as public safety personnel in Missouri. The reclassification would change the emergency telecommunicators' normal retirement age from 60 to 55 years.

The Board held a general discussion about the process and the cost of reclassifying the City's emergency telecommunicators. There was no opposition to reclassifying emergency telecommunicators.

General Discussion

The Board held a general discussion about the following items:

- MoDOT has a sign replacement/maintenance schedule on its website.
- Proposed price increase for Lake Saint Louis residents to purchase an annual pass to the Wentzville Recreation Center at the same rate as residents of the City of Wentzville.
- Maintenance issues on MoDOT's ramps.
